New Policy Initiatives for Promoting Student-Centred Higher Education

Wednesday, 14. October 2020, 14:00-16:30 CEST

There is widespread agreement both that education in the EHEA should become more student-centred *and* that implementation in daily practice is lagging. Hence, policy makers require new tools to encourage and incentivize institutions to reform their practices. This policy session will present new and innovative tools that policy makers, politicians and associations can use to encourage HEI's to adopt student-centred learning practices.

Co-Creative Learning in Higher Education: the CREATES toolkit for teachers

Thursday, 15. October 2020, 10:00-12:30 CEST

Dedicated to student-centred and co-creative classroom orientations, this session is open to all teachers and educators at European universities. The session will introduce the CREATES approach and launch the CREATES Classroom Toolkit with presentations on specific engaging techniques, such as PBL, RBL, (e)Portfolios, and Learning Communities.

Promoting Student Success Through Academic Advising: the CREATES #acadv toolkits for Higher Education

Friday , 16. October 2020, 10:00-13:00 CEST

University administrators, policy advisors and teaching staff are welcome to attend this session launching the CREATES toolkits for faculty advising, peer advising, and self-advising. Central questions will include: "How does advising benefit student success?" and "How does it relate to the mission of the university?" Come to learn with colleagues from universities across Europe and help students write the story of their education!

Creating Responsive and Engaging Education with Students

Friday , 16. October 2020, 14:00-16:00 CEST

Intended for university decision-makers and all those interested in innovative higher education in Europe, this session will explore the need for a more responsive and engaged approach to learning. It will consider the societal relevance of this approach, develop its major justifications, outline its main principles, and present evidence for its feasibility. Special attention will be given to the challenges the approach raises, such as international contexts, policy developments, and institutional reform, as well as the impact of the COVID-19 crisis on the educational model.
